

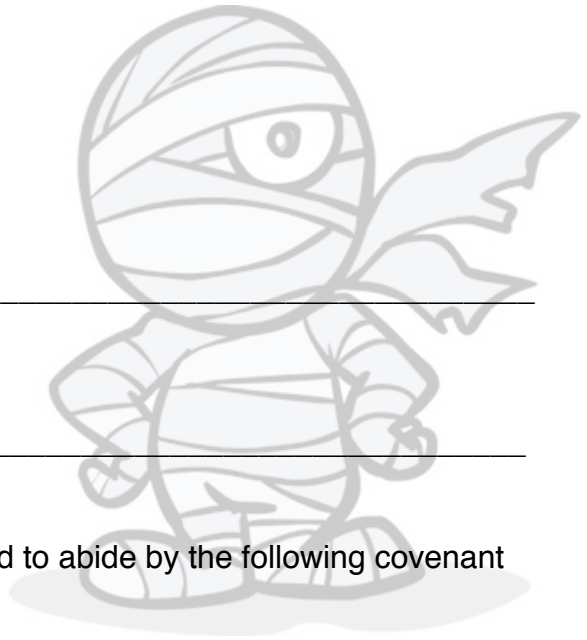
# MUMY Event Participation Consent Form

after both I and the student participant have agreed to abide by the following covenant of conduct:

- Participants will be expected to obey the rules given by adult chaperones and by the organization(s) which host this event. Adult chaperones will seek for the Spiritual, emotional, and physical wellbeing of participants and will abide by Safe Sanctuaries procedures.
- Possession of drugs, alcohol, weapons, or lewd material, to include songs or videos on personal electronic devices, are prohibited.
- Separating from the group, without the expressed permission of adults is not acceptable.
- Modesty will be maintained as a priority for the duration of the event. Boys are not allowed in areas designated for girls, and girls are not allowed in areas designated for boys, unless permission and escort are given by chaperones. Girls will wear one piece swimming attire or tankinis or will be asked to wear shirts overtop of their swimwear. Boys will need to keep shirts on for general athletic activities, even in high temperatures. Public displays of affection are not allowed at any time.
- Personal electronics, to include cell phones, will generally be allowed for use while traveling but prohibited during workshops and events. These are not allowed for use during designated sleeping times.
- Respect will be given for the property and reputation of the hosting organizations and each other. Vandalism or theft will not be tolerated.
- There will be absolutely no bullying or gossip intended to harm others. All students will be encouraged to seek for the wellbeing of others during the event. Profanity and excessive complaining negatively impact the group.
- Efforts will be made to sleep during designated sleeping times, as well as to let others sleep.

I understand that the typical method of addressing detrimental behavior is for two adults to directly confront the student, expecting a change in behavior. For repeated or especially serious violations, parents will be contacted, via the contact information listed on the student's "Health Form". If adult chaperones consider any behavior to be adversely affecting the entire group's participation in the event, arrangements will be made with the parents or guardians to send the participant home as soon as possible, at the expense of the participant's parent or guardian.
