

Manchester UMC Connection Coach Overview

Essential Skills

- Good listener
- Be able to recognize a person's interests and connect them to the various ministries
- Higher-level knowledge of MUMC ministries
- Active in MUMC ministries within the last three years.
- Familiarity with the MUMC website and/or Realm. (Not required)
- Desire to help others become more connected at Manchester UMC!

Role Description

1. Once assigned a new participant, coordinate a time/place to have a meeting/conversation. This can be on-site, off-site, via Zoom/phone, etc.
2. Use the participant's Spiritual Gifts Assessment results and the provided Spiritual Gifts Summary sheets to make recommendations for ministries. (If applicable)
3. Use the provided MUMC Ministries list and shared knowledge to help answer questions and determine which ministries the participants would be interested in.
4. If able/willing, use the church website to help "coach" the participant through the sign-up process.
5. Communicate the results from the meeting/conversation to the ministry leader (Jeff Haupt) so appropriate follow-up can happen with the interested ministries.
6. If able/willing, help serve as a Connection Coach at the Information Center on select Sunday mornings.
7. With guidance from staff/ministry leadership, provide continued follow-up with the participant.

Time Commitment

- Some first-time training may be required. No more than 30 minutes. There may also be opportunity to shadow a current Connection Coach.
- Each participant's meeting/conversation will vary, but typically allow for 30-40 minutes.
