Next steps for Connectionalism team:

Develop focus groups: existing groups, what do we want to know, develop script Questions: do these statements accurately reflect our story? Our identity? Do these

statements align with your vision for the church? Does this evoke alignment with future direction?

We want buy in. Is there something missing? Focus groups help with feeling like have input. Ask people input of how to roll out the new statements. Not want bog down in word-smithing. Focus groups help identify common themes of feedback.
